<p>QUALITY and AESTHETICS OF LAYOUT AND FORMATTING</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Overall organization of images and text (chronological, thematic, feeling or emotion, or image driven) ○ Placement and use of images and text on each page (use of space, eye movement, relationship between image and text, image quality, choice of text font and size) ○ Placement and use of text boxes and callouts (size, shape, relationship to image) 	<p>10 points</p>
